**LIVERPOOL X LONDON:  
GETTING OUR DOCKS IN A ROW**

London's Royal Docks were once the largest enclosed water body in the world and UK, whilst Liverpool has the largest amount of enclosed docks in the world and UK.

The Mayor of London, Sadiq Khan, reaffirmed his vision to restore London's Royal Docks into an iconic waterside destination with an announcement of £2bn public and private sector investment, via a 5-year strategy. Likewise, Liverpool has announced a new waterfront strategy, outlining ambitious plans for key waterfront development sites, including Kings Dock, Ten Streets and Liverpool Waters, which is also home to Everton FC's soon-to-be completed stadium, Bramley Moore.

So, how are two major UK cities working to both preserve and capitalise on their dock heritage, in line with wider economic ambitions? This event between Greater London Authority and Liverpool City Council will explore dock city development and investment in a post-industrial landscape.
